



Spike for a Cause pits locals vs imports in all-star benefit game

The Philippine SuperLiga will stage Spike for a Cause, a benefit game for typhoon Yolanda victims, on December 8 at 4pm to be held at the Ynares Sports Arena in Pasig City. The best local talent from all six teams in the women's division will come together to face the reinforcements suiting up in the PSL Grand Prix.

Team Solar Sports will be bannered by Lizlee Ann Gata-Pantone and Suzanne Roces of PLDT MyDSL, Tina Salak and Rachel Anne Daquis of TMS-Philippine Army, and Pau Soriano and Aiza Maizo-Pontillas of Cagayan Valley. Other players in the all-local squad include Chie Saet and Danika Gendrauli of Cignal, Melissa Gohing and Gretchen Ho of Petron, and Bernice Co and Ivy Remulla of RC Cola.

Team Score will be headed by Kaylee Manns and Savannah Noyes of PLDT MyDSL, Murakoshi Yuki and Wanitchaya Luangtonglang of TMS-Army, and Wanida Kotruang and Patcharee Sangmuang of Cagayan. They will be joined by Xie Lei and Li Zhazhan of Cignal, Shinako Tanaka and Misao Tanyama of Petron, as well as Sontaya Kaewbundit and Zhang Minghua of RC Cola.

The locals will be coached by Rico de Guzman of Army, Ernesto Pamilar of the Rising Suns, and Ronald Dulay of the RC Cola Raiders. Mentoring the other side are Sammy Acaylar of Cignal HD, Roger Gorayeb of PLDT, and Vilet Ponce de Leon of Petron Blaze.

All proceeds from ticket sales, voluntary contributions, and other donations will be turned over to the Philippine National Red Cross and to a non-government organization of the organizing committee's choosing. Team owners will also partake in a donation drive within their companies.

Admission is worth 150PHP in the lower level and 100PHP in the upper level. Tickets will be sold at the venue beginning on December 7.
